

Technical Bulletin

C-Weigh Fork Indicator Positive Battery Terminal Modification

Cascade has identified an issue with battery powered C-Weigh Fork Indicators that are loosing power due to a weak connection between the indicator positive contact plate and battery positive terminal. This bulletin covers indicators shipped prior to September 2018. Follow the steps below to solve the problem.

For the contact plate modification, Cascade is authorizing .5 hour for each indicator.

- **1** Remove the indicator from the mounting bracket.
- 2 Remove the rear battery cover from the indicator.
- **3** Remove the batteries from the indicator.
- 4 Insert a small screwdriver blade between the positive contact plate and slot in the indicator body. Turn the screwdriver blade to make a small bend the contact plate.



- **5** Reassemble the indicator. Press the indicator power ON button to confirm battery power is restored.
- **6** Reattach the indicator to the mounting bracket.
